



SUMMER READING GRADE TWO

Dear Parent,

We would like to continue the practice of encouraging students to read books appropriate to their reading level during the summer. Second graders are required to read at least two books. In some cases, these may be chapter books. Please help your child choose a book that he or she can read and respond to. A good way to tell if your child will be able to read a book is the Five Finger Rule. Have your child read the first page of the book. Each time they cannot read a word on their own they should put up a finger. If they put up five fingers on the first page or two, then the book is probably too difficult for them.

During their first grade experience with Mrs. Guarnera, the students learned about using a site map to tell the events of a story in order. Please have your child read the books and then have them use the attached site maps--(these look like flow charts)--to tell the events of the stories in order. These are to be handed in during the first week of school. Thank you!

I also suggest that students enter a summer reading program at the local library to enhance their appreciation of reading.

Complete and return the confirmation slip on the first week of school together with the site maps.
