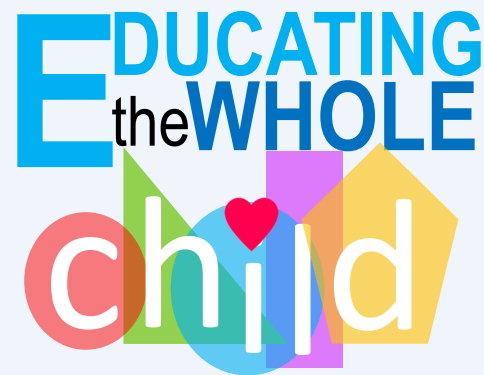
INTELLECTUAL

MORNING ACTIVITIES

A MORNING ROUTINE IS ESTABLISHED TO GIVE STUDENTS A SENSE OF CONFIDENCE AND INDEPENDENCE. THE STUDENTS HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO SOCIALIZE AND WORK INDEPENDENTLY ON SEAT WORK THAT IS DESIGNED TO ENRICH THE CURRICULUM. TIME IS SET ASIDE FOR THE STUDENTS TO RECITE THE PLEDGES AND START THE DAY WITH PRAYER.



BIBLE

STUDENTS LEARN WHO GOD IS BY STUDYING HIS WORD, MEMORIZING SCRIPTURE, AND EXAMINING THE LIVES OF BIBLICAL CHARACTERS. UNDERSTANDING AND INTEGRATING GODLY CHARACTER TRAITS SETS A FOUNDATION FOR STUDENTS TO APPLY BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES IN THEIR EVERYDAY LIVES.



READING

STUDENTS LEARN THE FOUNDATIONS OF READING, WRITING, JOURNALING, AND PHONEMIC AWARENESS. READING GROUPS ARE DESIGNED TO CULTIVATE A LOVE FOR READING, LAY THE FOUNDATION FOR READING SKILLS, EXPAND SITE RECOGNITION, INCREASE FLUENCY, AND DEVELOP COMPREHENSION.



MATH

STUDENTS ARE INTRODUCED TO AGE-APPROPRIATE MATH CONCEPTS AND SKILLS, SUCH AS: SORTING, MEASURING, SEQUENCING, LEARNING MONEY VALUES, COUNTING, RECOGNIZING NUMBERS, TELLING ANALOG CLOCK TIME, IDENTIFYING GEOMETRIC FIGURES, AND ADDING AND SUBTRACTING.



SCIENCE AND HISTORY

STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT GOD'S CREATION. TOPICS SUCH AS "WHAT IS LIVING AND NON-LIVING?" AND "LOOKING AT AND UNDERSTANDING MAPS AND GLOBES" ARE EXPLORED. THE STUDENTS ARE INTRODUCED TO THE CYCLE OF A BUTTERFLY, DINOSAURS, FAMOUS PEOPLE, HISTORICAL HOLIDAYS, COMMUNITY HELPERS, AND PERSONAL HYGIENE. WEEKLY READER PUBLICATIONS ARE USED TO SUPPLEMENT THE CURRICULUM.



RECESS

RECESS IS A BREAK IN THE DAY FOR OPTIMIZING STUDENTS' SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, PHYSICAL, AND COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT. IT OFFERS OPPORTUNITIES FOR BOTH POSITIVE PLAY AND EXPERIENCE IN LEARNING HOW TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

STUDENTS LEARN GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, SELF-CONTROL, AND TEAMWORK AS THEY PARTICIPATE IN SPORTS ACTIVITIES DURING CLASSTIME. PHYSICAL EDUCATION HELPS INSTILL PHYSICAL, COGNITIVE, AND SOCIAL SKILLS NECESSARY TO DEVELOP AND SUSTAIN A HEALTHY LIFESTYLE.



MUSIC

MUSIC CLASS IS DESIGNED TO REFINE FINE MOTOR SKILLS, IMPROVE EYE-HAND COORDINATION, ALLOW FOR SELF-EXPRESSION, AND STRENGTHEN MEMORY SKILLS. SINGING, SIGHT READING, MOVEMENT, PERFORMANCE, AND THE USE OF RHYTHM INSTRUMENTS, HELPS THE STUDENTS OBTAIN THE SKILLS NECESSARY FOR MUSIC READINESS.



LIBRARY

STUDENTS ARE INTRODUCED TO THE LIBRARY MEDIA CENTER THROUGH READ ALOUD SESSIONS, BOOK BROWSING, AUTHOR STUDIES, CHECK-OUT TIME, PROPER BOOK CARE, AND LIBRARY ETIQUETTE. THE MAIN OBJECTIVE IS TO ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO DEVELOP A LOVE OF READING.



CHAPEL

KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE WEEKLY ELEMENTARY CHAPEL WHERE EMPHASIS IS PLACED ON THE ATTRIBUTES OF GOD AND FOSTERING A LOVE FOR COMMUNITY WORSHIP.



ART

STUDENTS EXPLORE AND CREATE BY USING CLAY, PAINT, FABRIC, AND OTHER ART MATERIALS. THEY BUILD SCULPTURES, DESIGN COLLAGES, AND DRAW BY OBSERVATION. THEY GROW AS ARTISTS BY USING THEIR HANDS, HEAD, AND HEART.



SPANISH

STUDENTS ARE INTRODUCED TO SPANISH NUMBERS, THE ALPHABET, COMMON GREETINGS, AND GROUPED VOCABULARY. THEY LEARN PRIMARILY THROUGH IMITATION, REPETITION, SONGS, AND GAMES.



TECHNOLOGY

TECHNOLOGY CLASS INTRODUCES THE STUDENTS TO SIMPLE TASKS IN MICROSOFT WORD AND PUBLISHER. THE CLASS IS DESIGNED TO PREPARE STUDENTS TO BE LITERATE IN A DIGITAL WORLD.
